

Sowing paddocks through the summer cover crops in May – they did a great job of holding the sandhills



The seeding and post seeding period was characterised by strong gales – here sand blasting on wheat in foreground – subsequently recovered and now all sandhills stabilised

The cover crops after 4 weeks – doing their job holding the soil but now drought stressed



32 mm rain saved the cover crops and doubled their growth – now on March 25 we have to kill it to prepare for a new winter crop. Overall a success as no erosion on sandhills since end of January.
