

Credit Card Purchases – Description June 2022

The use of a credit card is a normal tool used to facilitate the business of Council. On occasion, items may need further explanation. Below is a brief explanation to accompany statements where the purpose of use is not evident in the accompanying documentation. All purchases were appropriately approved, in accordance with Council's Corporate Credit Card Policy.

Organisational Development Coordinator

Planning Institute of Australia

This transaction was for the renewal of planning accreditation for The Director of Community & Corporate and Assessment Manager. The transaction was made via credit card as it was deemed the most timely and efficient way of renewing the accreditation.

On The Run

Premium unleaded fuel was purchased on two occasions during June 2022. This fuel type is not accepted by BP fuel cards; hence a credit card was used to finalise the purchase. All Council staff have been advised that premium unleaded fuel is not to be purchased in the future as our contract with BP does not accept this form of fuel type.

Teamviewer

Council's Information Services Team Leader procured a remote desktop licence in order to 'dial in' to any staff member's PC real-time, allowing them to gain access to their desktop and troubleshoot any issues. A credit card was used to pay for the licence as it was deemed the most efficient way of obtaining the annual licence immediately.

The Manna of Hahndorf

A Roads & Infrastructure employee undertook White Card training in Mount Barker. Overnight accommodation was offered given the distance between the employee's residence/training venue and the time of the training course. The transaction involved the overnight tariff only and the employee did not occur any mini bar or meal expenses.

The purchase was for two load rates rings which are used for connection of the breakaway chains from our E-Combi roller to the tractor. This was a once of purchase from the supplier which is why we used credit card in lieu of setting up an account.

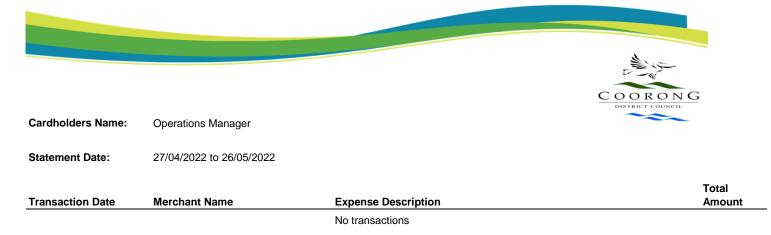
